

Tony Woolf's glass thickness checker

Print on thin card or thick paper.
Make sure that scaling is turned off when you print! The length of the card, before folding, should be 11.0 cm.

Cut out and fold sides up.

Hold at 45° to the glass. Look along the paper so that you see the double reflection, from the front and back surfaces of the glass.

Read the thickness (mm) in the pair of reflected circles that are nearest to just touching without overlapping.

It is easiest if there is more light on the near side of the glass than on the far side.

This works with standard glass, not laminated!
